The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Indianapolis Council (SVdP) vehicle donation program is administered, as part of a national program, by CARS (Charitable Adult Rides & Services) to offer supporters a new and meaningful way to contribute to SVdP. Donated vehicles drive forward SVdP's mission: <http://www.svdindy.org/about/#about-mission-values> , as well as protect the environment by properly removing unwanted vehicles from the road.

The partnership with CARS offers donors an easy way to repurpose any unwanted vehicles. Donating a vehicle is easy, tax-deductible, and avoids the hassles of selling or the costs of repairing altogether. Vehicle donations strengthen the programs provided by SVdP by directing all proceeds from the sale of vehicles to Parish Conferences within our Council.

Many of our donors are familiar with the work of Saint Vincent de Paul through the Council Food Pantry and Distribution Center providing food, furniture, appliances, bedding and clothing to families throughout Central Indiana. The work performed in each of our fifty-six Parish Conferences is highly personalized to the unique needs of families seeking help from local Parish's. Assistance can take many forms from personal services or payments for rent, utilities, food or medical needs. Proceeds from the sale of your vehicle have been used exclusively to support Parish Conferences throughout the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, for providing financial assistance to their clients.

CARS will guide donors throughout the entire donation process and provides a free and convenient pick-up. The system is zip code based, so donors have the option of designating the net proceeds to the nearest SVdP Parish Conference. Undesignated donations within the Archdiocesan Indianapolis area boundaries result in net proceeds being delivered to the SVdP Indianapolis Council. However 100% of the funds are distributed to the Parish Conferences most in need of funds for direct aid to the poor. Many nonprofits across the U.S. rely greatly on their vehicle donation program as a stable source of funds. CARS is the largest nonprofit vehicle donation provider and a trusted partner to over 3,500 other nonprofits in North America.
