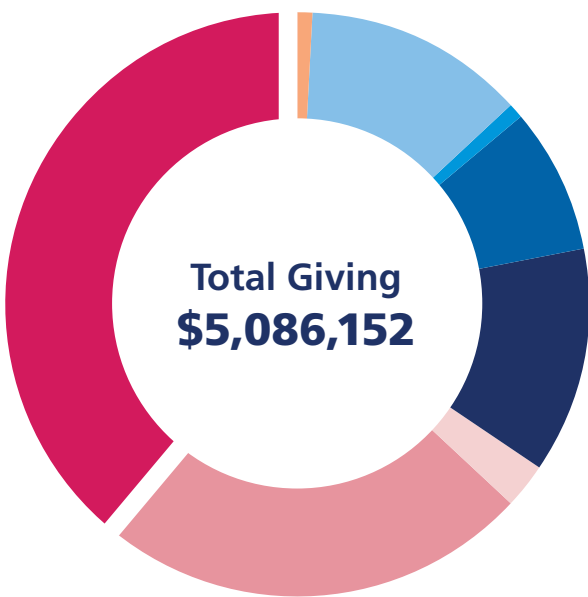
Through our conferences, SVdP Indy serves communities throughout Central, South Central and Southern Indiana—all within the counties on the map below.
