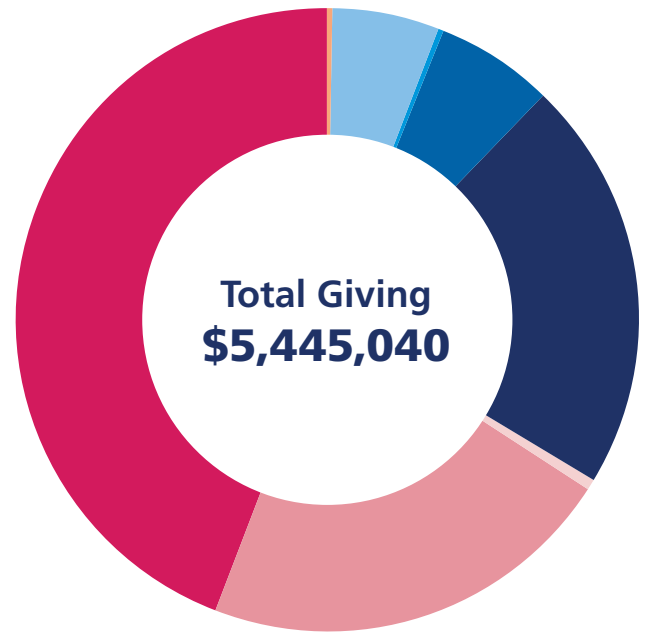
70% graduated CLF
