Unload Deliveries, Organize, and Clean Pantry - Tuesday and Friday
Support Shopping Hours - Wednesday, Thursday, and Saturday

Positional Tasks

Deliveries/Pantry Support

- Help to unload food deliveries
- Organize food within the pantry
- Perform general cleaning tasks to prepare for shopping days

Shopping Support

Ensure pantry stays stocked while helping shoppers fill carts, pack bags, and load groceries

Intake

Process shoppers, entering information into database

Skills and Expectations

- Volunteers tend to be active, lifting and moving items
- Volunteers should value compassion and dignity
- Opportunity to build one-on-one relationships with shoppers
